Priority Area Definitions

Adopted November 30, 2011

Priority Development Area (PDA): An area targeted for future development or redevelopment where the local communities will promote use of the land, community services, and existing or planned infrastructure with maximum efficiency while minimizing the impact on the watershed.

Priority Conservation Area (PCA): An area where local communities are encouraged to promote the conservation of land for its unique natural, cultural, recreational or historical value.

Priority Agricultural Area (PAA): An area that local communities target for continued, expanded and/or intensified agricultural activities due to historical, cultural, natural or human-created traits which make it conducive to agriculture and related activities while minimizing the impact on the watershed.
